Additionally, centralized access is provided to a paperless invoice platform (bProcess), as well as to the Airbus Helicopters, Sharepoint and BoostAero information exchange forums.

The portal will soon be enhanced with additional features designed to foster collaboration through performance indicators such as On Time Delivery, On Time Quality and Turn Around Time, and to enable the distribution of documents and the management of quality notes and equipment-development fact sheets.

The Airbus Helicopters Partner Portal is a secure platform accessible only to Airbus Helicopters partners. Manufacturers looking to offer their services to Airbus Helicopters will also be able to provide information on what they do and their areas of expertise via the entry page of the platform.
